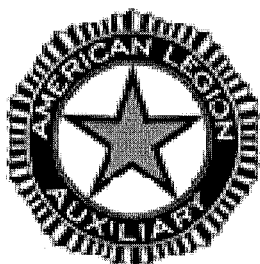

Dear High School Counselor and High School Principal:

We are excited that the planning for the 75th Session of the American Legion Auxiliary Arkansas Girls State for 2017 is underway. As previously noted, Arkansas Girls State will again be held on the campus of Harding University in Searcy from May 28 through June 2, 2017.

We are also excited to tell you of our recent advancements on our website and our Online Registration Portal which will help get information more quickly to you at the High School and to the Students, as well as the American Legion Auxiliary Unit assisting your school. These advancements will aid in the collection of information we will need and also to the overall Enrollment Application process.

Please take a moment to visit: www.ArkansaGirlsState.com

Our first step this year is to register your school online at our website. Registering your school as soon as possible will enable us to get information to you, and also to allow you to see the activity of your students enrolling. After the students have been vetted and selected by your teachers, then the students should also be directed to register at the website as a Delegate and add information on their profile. This year, the students may go in and out of their portal as needed, and be notified by us of any documents they are required to submit. An added feature this year is that the students may upload their documents into their profile.

When it is time to enroll your students into the Arkansas Girls State program, **it is as easy as 1-2-3.**

1. Select your students and have them register online as a Delegate
2. Collect the original Enrollment Application form and the original Documentation Requirements form.
3. Send those two pages and a check for \$200 for each student attending. If an Auxiliary Unit is assisting you with sponsorship, give those two pages for each student to your American Legion Auxiliary Unit Representative for processing.

ALL DOCUMENTS AND FEES MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN APRIL 28, 2017.

Please take a moment before submitting the forms required to ensure every area is thoroughly completed. The signatures of the student, parent, school and Auxiliary Unit are required. As your students register online, you will see them in your portal. When the student has submitted all of their required documents, you will see when they are accepted into the program. Let us know if a student is registered in your portal that you have not selected. Registering on the website, or submitting paperwork does not guarantee placement in the Arkansas Girls State program.

Once the student is accepted and placed into the program, the student will receive a Congratulatory Letter in their email and it will also post in their registration portal. This Congratulatory Letter and Delegate/Citizen Packet will give the student all other requirements and the documents to bring with them when they arrive on the campus of Harding University at Noon on May 28, 2017.

The \$200 Registration fees for the students must be secured by the high school or an American Legion Auxiliary Unit. These funds should be secured by sponsorship from various community, civic, fraternal and businesses. The Registration fee is not to be paid by the student or their family, but rather this fee should be paid by sponsorship through a local Auxiliary Unit, the school or other community, civic or fraternal organization, or local businesses. Organizations may share expenses. The Registration Fee is non-refundable.

ALA Arkansas Girls State is the premier program of the American Legion Auxiliary Department of Arkansas and prepares girls to become tomorrow's government and civic leaders. The program also seeks to instill a greater appreciation of Americanism in our Country's youth.

It is an honor to be selected to participate in the American Legion Auxiliary Arkansas Girls State program.

We appreciate your assistance and dedication you have shown to the students at your school in their selection to attend Arkansas Girls State.

My daughter has registered as a Delegate/Citizen and set up a profile at www.arkansasgirlsstate.com – and I understand that by completing these steps does not guarantee a place at Arkansas Girls State. When accepted, the student will receive an email with a congratulatory letter and her assignments. This will also be available in the profile after she has registered on the website.

Read Carefully:

Eligibility to participate in ALA Arkansas Girls State:

High school girls eligible to participate in the ALA Girls State/Girls Nation programs must have completed their Junior year of high school and have at least one semester remaining, be a United States citizen or legal inhabitant of the United States as evidenced by a current and/or valid birth certificate, visa, passport, Green Card or other United States government-issued documentation verifying a legal presence in the United States for at least the duration of the ALA Girls State/Girls Nation program. For any girl to be eligible to take part in the ALA Girls Nation program, she must be able to clear a background check by the United States government, the White House and the U.S. Secret Service. Documentation and verification must be provided onsite, and that failure to provide documents will result in ineligibility to participate in ALA Girls Nation with all expenses incurred up to that point becoming a responsibility of the parent/guardian.

Legal Inhabitanace

I attest that my daughter (ward) has a U.S. government-issued birth certificate or legal documentation of her legal presence in the United States provided by the U.S. government (e.g. visa, Green Card, passport). I understand that upon arrival and registration at ALA Girls State, I am expected to provide a bona fide copy of her birth certificate or her U.S. Government-issued documentation proving that she is a legal inhabitant of the United States for the duration of the event. If I fail to provide current and valid documentation, my daughter will not be allowed to take part in ALA Girls State and I, as parent/guardian, will be responsible for all expenses incurred up to that point in time.

Gender:

The ALA Girls State/Girls Nation leadership development programs are week-long 24/7 programs for high school girls. Participation is limited to females, as evidenced by her birth certificate or a sworn statement signed by a licensed medical doctor. The student must be a female at the time the program takes place.

Eligibility to Serve:

The purpose of the ALA Girls State/Girls Nation programs is to provide a nonpartisan participatory program that teaches eligible high school females responsible citizenship grounded in ethics, the principles of our nation's founders and respect for God and Country. For consistency among the 50 states presenting ALA Girls State programs, each program should conform to the structure of its corresponding state government as specified by its state constitution. ALA Girls Nation is modeled after the provisions in the United States Constitution.

INFORMATION ABOUT OUR 75TH SESSION OF ARKANSAS GIRLS STATE May 28th to June 2, 2017

WHAT IS THE AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY GIRLS STATE?

- It is a National program of the American Legion Auxiliary and is a course of instruction in, as well as, a practical application of, the fundamental principles and procedures of city, county and state government under the American system. ALA Girls State is a unique and exciting government-in-action learning program in which Auxiliary members guide young women to become knowledgeable stewards of freedom, democracy and patriotic citizens.
- A session, usually lasting five days, is conducted by each of the 50 states and the District of Columbia, with the top-ranking high school girls as citizens.
- Under the guidance of skilled counselors and other staff members who are leading citizens, these girls learn and then practice through self-government, the duties, responsibilities and privileges of American citizenship.
- ARKANSAS GIRLS STATE is sponsored, as it has been since 1940, by the American Legion Auxiliary, Department of Arkansas with local Auxiliary units and interested civic, community, fraternal and patriotic organizations cooperating.
- From the time they arrive, until they leave for home the citizens will get regular "sessions" of instruction in practical application of government and citizenships.
- These instruction sessions, conducted by the Government Instructor and the Girls State staff will include the principles and procedures of city, county and state government.
- Using the know-how gained from these classes, the citizens will organize and operate their own city, county and state governments.
- Emphasis will be placed on letting the students govern themselves, under the constant guidance of the staff members. Upon arrival at Harding University in Searcy, Arkansas, the citizens will be assigned to cities and counties, to form the mythical 51st State of Girls State.
- Early in the week, each city will elect officials, who will operate the city government during the week.
- Later, each county will elect county officials. There will be appointed officials at all levels of government.
- Each student will be assigned to a political affiliation, (Nationalist or Federalist), City, County, Dorm, Room and bed. Students from the same school will not be placed together.
- A State General Election will take place, in which the Girls State Governor and other State Officials will be elected. The students will come to the Capitol in Little Rock, and meet and mirror their elected counterparts.
- **This fee of \$200.00 is paid by the Auxiliary Units or other civic, community or business sponsorship. The fee shall not be paid by citizens, parents or any family member of a citizen.** The Auxiliary Units raise the sponsorship fees through donations, fund raisers and various other sources.

HEALTH OF ARKANSAS GIRLS STATE CITIZENS:

- Good Health and physical fitness are MOST essential to each Arkansas Girls State Citizen. Citizens will NOT be allowed to register for Girls State on arrival day without the Girls State Medical Form completely filled out. The top portion of the Medical Form must be completed by a physician or nurse practitioner. School Athletic Physicals for the current school year will be accepted in place of the top portion of the form and should be stapled to the form. The bottom portion of the Medical Form MUST be signed by the child's parent or guardian and include health insurance information. There will be a nurse attending Arkansas Girls State as a member of the Arkansas Girls State staff, and the intent of this information is to provide medical personnel with accurate health history to provide appropriate care.

HEALTH OF ARKANSAS GIRLS STATE CITIZENS (cont.):

- If your child becomes sick prior to attending Arkansas Girls State, please withdraw your child from the program. If your child becomes sick while attending Arkansas Girls State, she will be withdrawn from the program and dismissed to a parent or guardian. The nurse will be in communication with the parent or guardian in times of illness. These guidelines will be strictly enforced because of the close proximity of living quarters in college dormitories in an effort to prevent spreading of illness.

PARTICIPANT EXCLUSIONS:

- ALA Arkansas Girls State programs, as well as the ALA Girls Nation program are not designed for and may exclude pregnant or drug abusing teenage girls. ALA Arkansas Girls State and Girls Nation are designed for female high school students who are serious about and capable of carrying out the rigors of leadership. Because of possible medical implications, excluding girls who are pregnant or who are abusing drugs is appropriate, allowable, and removed a potential liability for the program.

WHAT TO BRING AFTER BEING ACCEPTED INTO THE PROGRAM:

- When you arrive on the Campus of Harding University on May 28th at Noon, you will check in at your Dorm assignment, which you will receive with your congratulatory letter.
- Bring your fully completed assignment packet and be ready to check-in to your dorm.
- Bring Originals and a copy of your medical Insurance card, even if you have uploaded them to your Delegate/Citizen profile on the website at www.arkansasgirlsstate.com
- Bring your original document of being a United States citizen or legal inhabitant of the United States with a current and/or valid birth certificate, visa, passport, Green Card or other United States government-issued document verifying a legal presence in the United States. Originals must be presented, even if you have uploaded them to your profile on the website.
- Bring your original physical document performed by a licensed medical doctor.
- Bedding for the dorm room.
- Items on the supplies list included in your Delegate/Citizen Acceptance packet.

MEDICAL CARE:

- Prior to applying to Girls State, every applicant must receive a physical from a qualified Physician or Nurse Practitioner to verify the health of the student and determining whether or not the Citizen is physically qualified to participate fully in the Program. The proof of a physical will be uploaded on the student profile of the website. The Student is required to present the completed Delegate Packet and proof of insurance and medical physical at the on-site registration at Harding University on May 28, 2017.
- Infirmary facilities and medical personnel will be provided throughout the week, to render any needed medical attention to citizens and staff members.

DELEGATE/CITIZEN INFORMATION PACKETS:

- **Once the student applications have been received and processed, the student Enrollment Applications will be reviewed. If the student is accepted to be a Citizen/Delegate to attend Arkansas Girls State, they will receive notification in their online student profile and through an email. Completing all the documents and registering online does not guarantee a place at Arkansas Girls State.**
- The Congratulatory Acceptance packet includes important information and complete instructions on rules and regulations, general information, what to bring from home and other facts which citizens should know before leaving home for Girls State, Scholarship Information, Variety show or Band information and the Girls State Pledge. These must be turned in during registration on Sunday.
- If you have not received your packet by May 16th, please contact us at the American Legion Auxiliary Department Headquarters by calling (501) 374-5836.

FOOD ALLERGIES/DIETARY RESTRICTIONS:

- The cafeteria on Harding's campus provides breakfast, lunch, and dinner for all delegates, counselors, and staff. If a delegate has any food allergy or dietary restriction such as peanut allergy, gluten allergy, vegan, etc. that delegate must notify Girls State no later than one week prior to the start of the program so that arrangements and accommodations can be addressed with Harding's staff. These special needs requests can be sent by email to ALA.ArkansasSecretary@yahoo.com.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE:

- Citizens must report to the campus and Dorm assignment at Harding University, Searcy, Arkansas, between 12:00 Noon and 12:30 p.m. on Sunday, May 28th, and they will depart on Friday, June 3 at 12:00 Noon.
- **LUNCH will NOT be provided on Sunday**; arrangements must be made prior to arriving at Girls State.
- **Once the citizen has registered, they are not allowed to leave to eat lunch. Make sure you have eaten lunch before arriving on campus.**
- Inauguration and Graduation will be Wednesday, May 31, 2017, at 7:00 p.m. in Benson Auditorium. Doors open for guests at 6:30 p.m.
- The sponsoring American Legion Auxiliary Unit is responsible to assist the Citizens selection with questions and to prepare them for the Arkansas Girls State week.

HOUSING AND MEALS:

- All citizens and staff members will be housed in the dormitories on the campus of Harding University, in Searcy, Arkansas, and the meals will be served. Citizens and Delegates may not leave the campus at any time to purchase meals, and may not go to any other vendors or retail establishments on or around campus.
- Participants of Girls State may not order food to be brought to them by restaurants, family or friends.

- **No visitors are allowed during the week. Family members MAY attend the Inauguration on Wednesday evening.**
- **Nothing can be delivered to citizens unless through the Girls State office and only with the permission of the Arkansas Girls State Director.**
- **All citizens will be required to comply with all rules of conduct and general discipline by the Girls State Staff and Counselors. This includes showing respect to all staff members and fellow citizens.**
- **Only an extreme emergency will be a reason for leaving Girls State before the end of the session, and only with the permission of the Arkansas Girls State Director..**

GIRLS NATION:

- Two outstanding citizens of the American Legion Auxiliary Arkansas Girls State session will be selected by delegates and staff to attend Girls Nation.
- All expenses of the two citizens will be paid from the Girls State Fund.

SAMSUNG SCHOLARSHIP:

- Each qualified student is encouraged to apply for the SAMSUNG Scholarship. For this Session in 2017, all SAMSUNG Applications are to be **completed online prior** to attending Arkansas Girls State. Once the student arrives on the campus of Harding University, the application period is expired.

HEALTH OF **ARKANSAS GIRLS STATE CITIZENS:**

Good Health and physical fitness are MOST essential to each Arkansas Girls State Citizen. Citizens will NOT be allowed to register for Girls State on arrival day without the Girls State Medical Form completely filled out. The top portion of the Medical Form must be completed by a physician or nurse practitioner. School Athletic Physicals for the current school year will be accepted in place of the top portion of the form and should be stapled to the form. The bottom portion of the Medical Form MUST be signed by the child's parent or guardian and include health insurance information. There will be a nurse attending Arkansas Girls State as a member of the Arkansas Girls State staff, and the intent of this information is to provide medical personnel with accurate health history to provide appropriate care.

If your child becomes sick prior to attending Arkansas Girls State, please withdraw your child from the program. If your child becomes sick while attending Arkansas Girls State, she will be withdrawn from the program and dismissed to a parent or guardian. The nurse will be in communication with the parent or guardian in times of illness. These guidelines will be strictly enforced because of the close proximity of living quarters in college dormitories in an effort to prevent spreading of illness.
